## BOROUGH OF JERSEY SHORE COUNCIL MEETING January 8, 2018 7:00 p.m.

<u>Council President</u>: President Zellers informed all Council and the public that meetings were recorded for official record keeping.

President Zellers presented the December 11, 2017 and the January 2, 2018 Minutes. Councilor Simcox made a Motion to approve the December 11, 2017 and the January 2, 2018 Minutes. Councilor Dyroff seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 7/0.

President Zellers presented his appointments of each Council Member to fill positions on Borough Committees for the years 2018 and 2019.

<u>Borough Manager</u>: Mr. Hamm presented Resolution 01.08.2018.01 appointing Lycoming County as the tax collector for the Borough of Jersey Shore. Councilor Garrett made a Motion to approve Resolution 01.08.2018.01. Councilor Barnhart seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 7/0.

Mr. Hamm presented Resolution 01.08.2018.02 opposing House Bill 1620 entitled the "Wireless Infrastructure Deployment Bill" which would provide a statewide preemption of local zoning for wireless facilities. Councilor Dyroff made a Motion to approve Resolution 01.02.2018.08 opposing House Bill 1620. Councilor Haag seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 7/0.

Mr. Hamm presented a proposal and quote from Larson Design Group to complete the Active Transportation Plan for the Borough in the amount of \$17,500. Mr. Hamm indicated the Borough received \$16,000 in grant funding from PA WalkWorks for the Active Transportation Plan and that the Borough would be required to pay the remaining

\$1,500 balance for the Active Transportation Plan. Councilor Simcox made a Motion to approve the proposal and quote from Larson Design Group for the Active Transportation Plan and pay the balance of \$1,500. Councilor Dyroff seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 7/0.

Mr. Hamm presented an amendment to the SEDA-COG Professional and Technical Services Agreement for the Owner-occupied Housing Rehabilitation Program. Mr. Hamm stated the Amendment was necessary because SEDA-COG is incurring additional costs to interview homeowners who end up being ineligible for the Program. The amendment does not increase the Borough's administrative costs but rather re-budgets funds from other administrative line items. Councilor Schmouder made a Motion to approve the amendment to the Professional and Technical Services Agreement. Councilor Simcox seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 7/0.

Mr. Hamm presented the 2018 List of Annual Events. Councilor Dyroff made a Motion to approve the 2018 List of Annual Events. Councilor Garrett seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 7/0.

Mr. Hamm presented draft Ordinance 2018-01 which would adopt the 2018 International Property Maintenance Code for advertising. Councilor Schmouder made a Motion to approve advertising Ordinance 2018-01. Councilor Dyroff seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 7/0.

Mr. Hamm presented a request from Jeff and Amy Rankinen to use the boat launch on June 16 and 17, 2018 for the 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Keystone Challenge Canoe and Kayak Race. Councilor Garrett made a Motion to approve the request of Jeff and Amy Rankinen to use the boat launch on June 16 and 17, 2018 for the 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Keystone Challenge Canoe and Kayak Race. Councilor Simcox seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 7/0.

<u>Mayor</u>: Mayor Thompson presented a letter informing Council that he would begin performing marriage services.

<u>Borough Solicitor</u>: Solicitor Dieter indicated that the Borough property located at 1204 Locust Street is still deeded in the name of Jersey Shore Sanitation Authority. Solicitor Dieter explained there was language in the Ordinance and deeds that when the Jersey Shore Sanitation Authority disbanded the properties owned by the Authority would be transferred back to the Borough as a successor in interest. Councilor Dyroff made a Motion to approve filing an updated deed that transfers 1204 Locust Street from the

Sanitary Authority to the Borough as a successor in interest. Councilor Schmouder seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 7/0.

<u>Finance Committee</u>: Councilor Dyroff presented the January 2018 bills in the amount of \$47,544.44. Councilor Dyroff made a Motion to pay the January 2018 bills in the amount of \$47,544.44. Councilor Garrett seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 7/0.

Councilor Dyroff presented the Voya report from December 2017.
