Zoning, Codes & Planning

Permits: Permits are required for everything except painting, wall coverings, and floor coverings. Residents are required to complete an application form prior to a permit being issued. To make an appointment, please contact Jim by calling 570-398-0104.

Snow Removal: All snow and ice must be removed from sidewalks 24 hours after a storm has stopped. Snow may not be shoveled or blown into the street at any time.

Winter Parking Ordinance 2016-02: During a winter storm emergency, parking prohibitions/restrictions within the Borough of Jersey Shore will be in effect. The declaration and termination of the winter storm emergency shall be provided to the radio and television. In the event the Borough Manager declares a winter storm emergency, on odd days parking shall be permitted only on the odd addressed sides of the street and on even days, parking shall be permitted only on the even addressed sides of the street. These restrictions will be in effect until the winter storm emergency is declared over. Any vehicle parked or left unattended on any street during the forty-eight (48) hour period after a winter storm shall be declared abandoned and can be towed and stored. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$1,000, plus costs and/or to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 90 days. Each day that a violation of the Ordinance occurs shall be found to constitute a separate offense.

Nothing in this section shall be construed as a full Ordinance. A full text copy of all Ordinances and the IPMC above are available at the Borough Office.
