## BOROUGH OF JERSEY SHORE COUNCIL MEETING October 11, 2021 7:00 p.m.

Amendment of the Agenda: Mr. Hoover made a request to have an Amendment to the Agenda, due to Resolution 10.21.2021.01 being received within 24 hours of the Council Meeting. Councilor Schmouder made a motion to approve the Amendment to the Agenda. Councilor Dennis seconded the motion. The Motion carried 7/0.

<u>Council President</u>: Council President Zellers presented September 13, 2021 Minutes. Councilor Schmouder made a Motion to approve the Minutes. Councilor DeLaney seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 7/0.

<u>Public</u>: Diane Carothers was concerned about the vacant properties in the Borough, exclusively Mr. Wolf's property on Seminary Street. She said that there has been an increase in the snake and rodent population. She stated that she brought this up in the September Council Meeting, and would like to know if there was an update to the situation. She would like to know who owns the property, who is maintaining it, and if the home is for sale. Council President Zellers stated that they will look into the matter, and they will update her with her with the status of the property. Diane asked who made the road a one way by the school. She stated that the road being a one way, is causing a delay in transit getting to the homes by the school. President Zellers stated that they will look into the matter and see if the school does in fact own the roadway, that they have changed to a one way. Diane asked about the dock update. Mr. Hoover stated that they would be going over the dock update in the meeting.

John Shireman commented on the one-way road concern from Diane Carothers, he stated that it is an issue for the residents in the area of the one-way road. John mentioned that he would like to see the council meetings livestreamed, he mentioned this at the last meeting and was wandering the status of this. President Zellers stated that they are looking into this, but a final decision has not been made yet. John mentioned that he feels

there should be two sections in the Agenda for Public Comment Sections, one in the beginning and one in the end. John would like to see a public Treasurer Report of the cash spent and vendor payments. John expressed concerns with the Public Building, and how much the Architectural fees are, as well as how much money has been spent on the design phase. President Zellers stated that he would be getting with the Borough Manager to discuss the concerns.

<u>Borough Manager</u>: Mr. Hoover presented Resolution 10.11.2021.01 approving the submission of the Redevelopment Assistance Capital Grant application to DCED for \$1,000,000.00. Councilor Simcox made the motion to approve Resolution 10.11.2021.01. Councilor Thompson seconded the motion. The motion carried 7/0

Mr. Hoover presented the 5-Year Paving Plan. Councilor DeLaney made the motion to approve the 5-Year Paving Plan. Councilor Garrett seconded the motion. The motion carried 7/0.

Mr. Hoover requested a motion to continue pursuing the Public Service Building, along with the TVRPD, Independent Hose, and Citizen Hose. Councilor Thompson made the motion to approve continued pursuing of the Public Service Building. Councilor Schmouder seconded the motion. The motion carried 7/0.

Mr. Hoover presented the road closure request from the Future Business Leaders of America, for the weShorecare Community Service Project, as well as the Football playoff/home game. The weShorecare dates would be November 4, 5 and 18, 2021. The Football playoff/home games would be November 1-21, 2021. Councilor Schmouder made the motion to approve the Future Business Leaders of America, road closure events. Councilor DeLaney seconded the motion. The motion carried 7/0.

Mr. Hoover announced the Town Meeting tentative dates for the Annual Christmas Block Party & Santa Parade December 4, 2021 at 4:00 PM, and the Tree lighting ceremony on December 4, 2021 at 7:00 PM.

Mr. Hoover presented the Trade Eastern, Inc. Road closure request for the installation of the new MRI at Geisinger Hospital. The street that will be affected will be the section of Howard Street, between the intersections of Kerr Ave. and Howard Street. Letters are being mailed to the affected residences. Councilor Schmouder made the motion to approve the Trade Eastern, Inc., road closure event for January 8, 2022 from 7:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Councilor Simcox seconded the motion. The motion carried 7/0

Mr. Hoover presented the update on the Dock. Two weeks ago, the dock floated down the river, and became stuck along the bank below Sweitzer's Garage property. The borough at the time of the flooding was understaffed. Due to being understaffed, it was a safety hazard to use the employees available to remove the dock before/during the flooding. The dock has been retrieved, and only sustained minor damages. The Borough will be able to repair the dock damages. Mr. Hoover would like to thank Sweitzer's Garage for allowing the Borough to enter their property, to retrieve the dock.

<u>Finance Committee</u>: Council President Zellers presented the October 2021 bills in the amount of \$69,253.10. Councilor Schmouder made a Motion to pay the October 2021 bills for \$69,253.10, Councilor DeLaney seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 7/0.
