Borough Manager: Introduced Coleman Gregory and Andrew Barton of Larson Design Group; to discuss the preliminary plans for the River Access Project.



Mayor Buttorff suggested widening the turning radius at the entrance/exit on Smith Street. All of Council agreed with both suggestions.

A Motion was made by Councilor Schmouder to allow Larson Design Group to move forward in preparing final design plans. Councilor Pisarcik seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 6/0.

A Motion was made by Councilor Garrett to obtain a Request for Proposals for signage for the River Access area. Councilor Scheesley seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 6/0.

A Motion was made by Councilor Scheesley for Borough Manager Joseph Hamm and Alice Trowbridge to apply to the National Park Service for a Grant so the project can be completed in one phase. Councilor Pisarcik seconded the Motion. The Motion carried 6/0.
